- Eligibility: Open to all currently enrolled students; volunteers must follow college policies, ASG standards, and event guidelines.
- Earning Hours: Must participate in ASG-sponsored or approved events and log hours through the official tracking system under supervision.
- Verification: All volunteer hours require approval from the Director of Student Communication.
- Minimum Activity Time: At least 1 hour per activity.
- Carryover: Unused hours can roll into the next semester; up to 20 hours may be retained within one academic year.
- Requirement for Recognition: Must complete 20 verified hours within the academic year.
- Recognition: Hours reviewed each Fall and Spring; eligible volunteers receive a certificate, appreciation gift, and may request a service letter.
