- Psychology Club, San José City College, is requesting ASG funding to support travel to the 2026 Western Psychological Association (WPA) Conference in Tacoma, Washington.
- Travel dates: April 29 – May 3, 2026; conference held at the Tacoma Convention Center.
- Participants: 11 Psychology Club students and 1 faculty advisor (12 total travelers).
- Five students will present research posters as first authors, representing the college in a regional academic setting.
- Conference activities include research presentations, professional development workshops, networking with graduate programs and professionals, and exploration of transfer and career pathways.
- Transportation plan: round-trip flight from San José International Airport (SJC) to Seattle–Tacoma International Airport (SEA).
- Estimated airfare: \$162 per person; \$1,782 total for 11 students (based on rates as of Feb. 23, 2026; subject to change).
- The experience supports public speaking, academic confidence, leadership development, graduate school preparation, and scholarly engagement, while helping students build skills for transfer to four-year universities.
- Students will share their knowledge and experiences with the campus community after returning, extending the educational impact.
